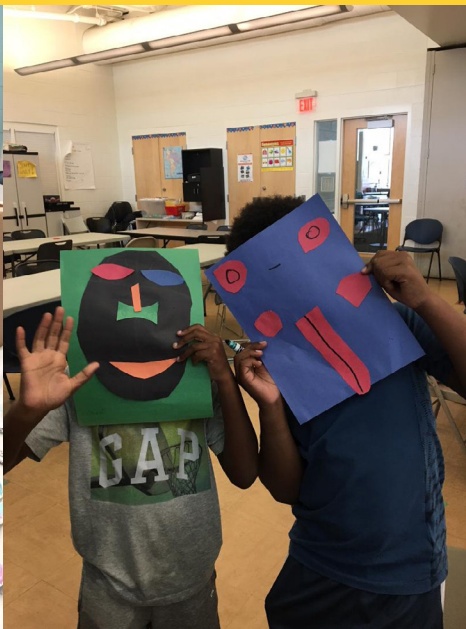

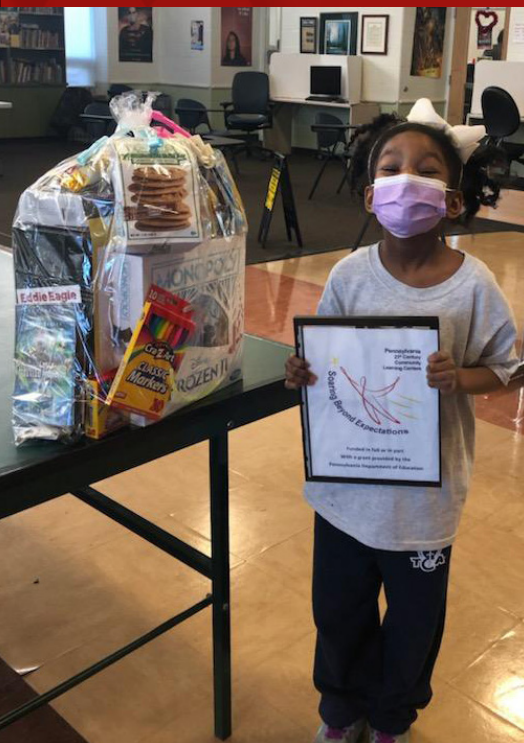
Executive Director

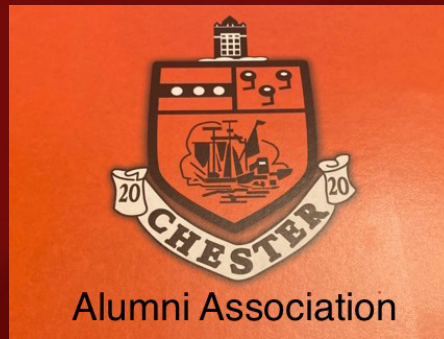

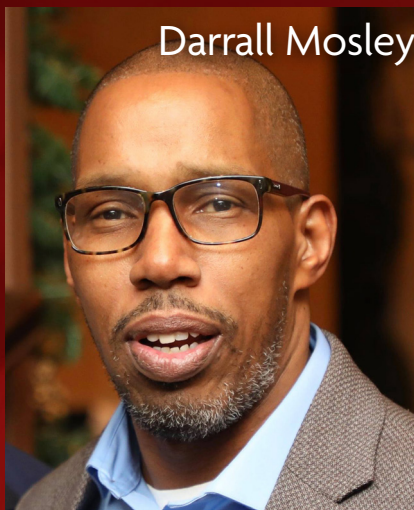

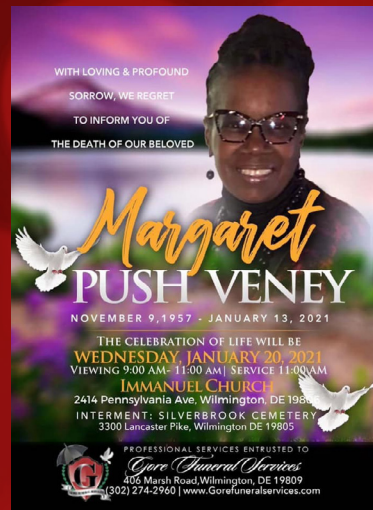

About George E. Carter



George Edward Carter was born on October 4, 1934, in Chester, Pennsylvania. George was a graduate of Chester High School and attended Cheyney State Teacher's College, now known as Cheyney University. He received his degree in early childhood education in 1957.

The young George Carter began teaching in 1960, spending the early part of his career at Wetherill Elementary from September 1966 to 1975. There, he also served as the Assistant Principal.

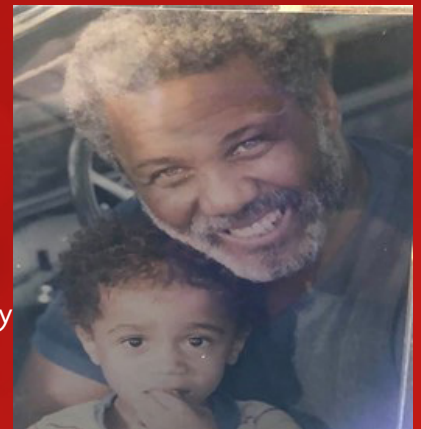
George Carter had a passion for coaching, and from 1984-1997, led the Chester High School girls' basketball team as assistant and then head, leading the team to two state championships. He taught in the Chester-Upland School District for more than 35 years retiring in 1995.

George Carter's life was about service to the youth of Chester. He believed that his purpose in life was to work to benefit others. He began working at the Chester Boys Club, which later became the Chester Boys and Girls Club, in 1958 and served in a variety of capacities there for more than 50 years, including as the athletic director and the executive director. He believed the Boys Club was part of the fabric of the Chester community. While the club was a recreational facility, under his leadership, the Club also served to stress the importance of education and to provide its young people with a sense of family. To many of the youth who were a part of the Club, George Carter was a father figure.

George Carter was "old-school.": He believed in hard work and discipline. While basketball was often how he got kids hooked, he taught them so much more than sports. He taught them to respect women. He taught them how to handle your finances. He taught them about life. And, he taught several generations that education was the key to success.

George Carter received numerous community recognitions for his work at the Boys and Girls Club and for his devotion to the community of young people in Delaware County. Some of these awards included being named Daily Times Coach of the Year in 1987 and being inducted into the Delaware County Athletes Hall of Fame in 2001. He has been called "the most successful amateur basketball coach in Chester."

George Carter was said to be responsible for the early athletic development of many cage greats such as basketball notables Wilbur and Charles Kirkland, Emerson Baynard, Henry Poteat, Paul (LOOTY) Williams, Harry McLaughlin, Len Gordy and Herman Harris and many others.



While George Carter received hundreds of accolades for this community service, nothing pleased him more was the success of his "Boys Club boys" and making sure they rooted their lives in Christ. His final honor was the new boys and girls club, a dream he worked so hard to fulfill. City officials, local politicians and other community leaders joined together to celebrate the opening of the new George E. Carter Center (Boys and Girls Club), located at Seventh and Madison streets in Chester.

George Carter was an active member of the Range's Temple Church of God in Christ. He served as Superintendent of the Sunday School and as Trustee and Deacon of the church. His philanthropy continues in many ways including financial contributions.

George Carter passed away November 7, 2010 surrounded by his family.
